1. The journal development

It is necessary to:

- register journal in CABI abstracts
- register journal in FSTA abstracts
- publish articles only in english language from the August 2013
- apply to the evaluation of the journal content in the Web of Science database in 2014

2. The extension of the editorial board

It is necessary to:

- extend editorial board members of five members from Western Europe
- extend editorial board members of five members from Northern America

3. International cooperation

It is necessary to:

- extend the reviewers members by the cooperation with the journal indexed in Web of Science or Scopus database

4. Journal strategy

It is necessary to:

- increase the number of scientific articles from EU member states about 30 % in the period of 2013 – 2014
- increase the number of scientific articles from the other states about 30 % in the period of 2013 2014
- increase the number of citations of articles published in Potravinarstvo in Web of Science or Scopus database about 20 % through the marketing activities of the journal in the field of international scientific conferences and seminars organised in the Czech republic, Poland, Austria, Hungary and Slovakia

5. Sustainable development

It is necessary to:

- implement CrossCheck iThenticate plagiarism tool
- start professional english language correction of each article
- find a strategic sponsor for the period of 2014 2018
- increase the publication fee from 60 EUR to 150 EUR and accumulate the capital for:
 - o implementation of the anti plagiarism software tool
 - o start the reviewer pay for the review creation
